



NOVEMBER BALLOT MEASURES

- # 86 -Student Opportunity Fund "Amends Constitution: Requires creation of fund for Oregonians pursuing post-secondary education, authorizes state indebtedness to finance fund." The fund would get revenue from General Obligation Bonds, which could be up to half billion dollars over the next state budget cycle.
- # 87 Allows State Judges to serve in the National Guard or as State College Professors. "Amends Constitution: permits employment of state judges by National Guard (military service) and state public universities (teaching)."
- # 88 Grant "Driver Card" to Oregon residents without legal presence. "Provides Oregon resident 'driver card' without requiring proof of legal presence in the United States." A referendum from the people in opposition to the vote of the legislature on Senate Bill 833.
- # 89 Oregon Equal Rights Amendment. "Amends Constitution: State/political subdivision shall not deny or abridge equality of rights on account of sex."
- # 90 Open Primary Initiative. Changes general election nomination processes: provides for single primary ballot listing candidates; top two advance."
- # 91 Control, Regulation, and Taxation of Marijuana and Industrial Hemp Act of 2014 "Allows possession, manufacture, sale of marijuana by/to adults, subject to state licensing, regulation, taxation."
- # 92 Labeling of Genetically Engineered Food "Requires food manufacturers, retailers to label "genetically engineered "foods as such; state, citizens may enforce."

She urges all to call Oregon's Secretary of State, Kate Brown at 503-986-1518, your county commissioners, and sheriff and police departments with these suggestions. Reducing the number of ballot drop sites, only accessible on Monday and Tuesday of

Reducing the number of ballot drop sites, only accessible on Monday and Tuesday of election week, locating them inside government buildings that can be closed and locked at night, Sheriff Deputies to be used for all ballot pick-ups plus additional sheriff protection during the ten days prior to election day at all county election offices. Now is the time to write legislation


