

Western Liberty Network Conference Recap

On Saturday January 24th, Western Liberty Network hosted their third annual Grassroots Conference in Portland. The tagline for the conference was "Taking the Offensive," the mission was to help inform and offer assistance to citizens to help them get more engaged in the political process. The event drew citizens from all corners of the State, from Eastern Oregon to the Willamette Valley.

The conference was filled with various breakout sessions designed around four main themes which were:

- •How to get elected/appointed to public office and serve effectively
- •How to lobby State Legislators and other office holders
- •How to circulate petitions and be an effective campaign volunteer
- •How to manage local campaigns and build your grassroots organization

The people who attended these breakout sessions came away with valuable techniques and tools that will aid them in becoming more involved and making a difference in their towns and communities.

Statewide Initiative signature gathering for "Lottery Local Control Act" for 2016 Election. Cliff Thomason of Grants Pass is chief petitioner. This proposal will send 50% of the Oregon Lottery net proceeds back to the counties from which they were generated. Counties can use the revenue to help fund: public education, economic development, providing for public safety, restoring native fish and wildlife or protecting parks and beaches. Every Oregon County will benefit from more local control. Single signature sheets and the complete text will be available at February's meeting.



There are the usual tax bills looming that will add uncertainty to our small businesses which could hurt them and prevent them from growing and expanding in our state. Not all of the issues facing our State are partisan issues, the need to better our schools, protect our voting system, and streamline processes for businesses to expedite bureaucratic red tape are not partisan issues but State issues that will need each Legislative chamber and the Governor to come together to fix and improve conditions for our next generation of citizens. The people need to become involved and engaged on issues that are important to them.

During the last week in January, the United Senate has been working hard on different initiatives to help spur growth and opportunity for not only our States, but our Nation. In his weekly email Senator Scott highlighted one of his initiatives on school choice. "This week I also introduced my CHOICE Act, a key piece of my Opportunity Agenda. The CHOICE Act will expand educational opportunities for children with disabilities, children living on military bases, and children living in lowincome communities. Today, sadly, not all of our children, through no fault of their own, have access to a quality education that allows them to reach their full God-given potential. 
