Elections are not won on Election Day - but through the work in the months leading up to it.



News Update from Congresswoman Marsha Blackburn of Tennessee

"Fellow Americans -

I know you are each well aware of my opposition to the Iran Nuclear Deal. There is nothing in the deal that serves us well. I have told you we would try some additional steps to stop the flow of \$150 billion to Iran. This week we took one of those steps. 


