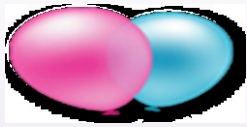

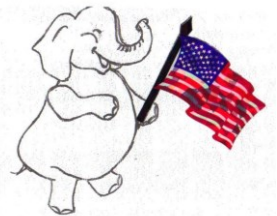

Our First Amendment, Freedom of Speech rights which include, religious freedoms, are threatened. Our Second Amendment, Right to Bear Arms is in danger of disappearing. 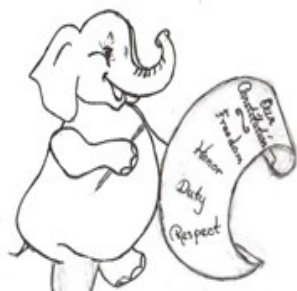

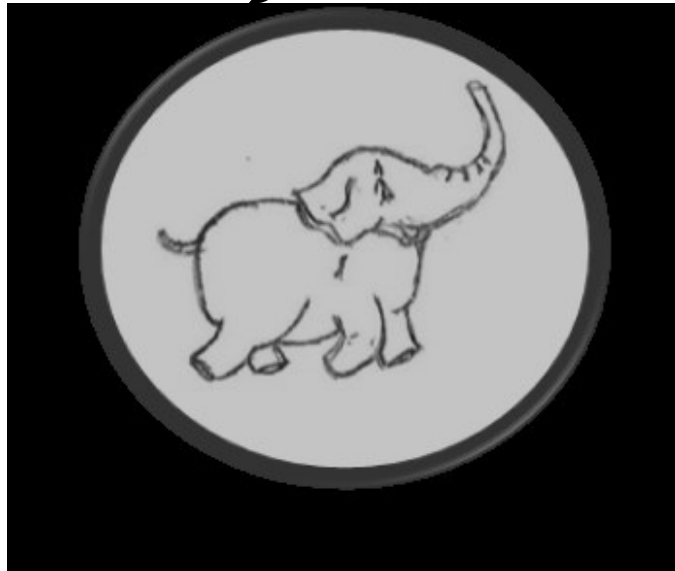
