The long days of Summer are upon us, hence the last Update before our regular Newsletter resumes in September. Our regularly scheduled Wednesday, September 12, 2018 meeting, will have Lori Chavez DeRemer, currently the Mayor of Happy Valley and a Candidate for Oregon's House District # 51 as our speaker. Additional candidates are always welcome to share their platforms with us.

Important Announcement There will be NO Executive Club Meeting in August. The next scheduled gathering of the "Don McIntire Activists" will be September 5th, 7 pm, at the Airport Shilo Inn, 11707 N.E. Airport Way. Speaker to be announced later.

As of this time, we will have 4 of our Initiative Petitions on the November 8th Ballot. "Stop Oregon Sanctuary Cities Law" which would repeal the state's 31 year-old sanctuary law. "A Tax is a Tax", a Constitutional Amendment to require a three-fifths vote of the House and Senate for raising revenue, including assessing fees and ending tax credits. "Stop Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act", this is also a Constitutional Amendment prohibiting use of public funds for most abortions, unless medically necessary or required by federal law. Tax-free food: "Yes! Keep Our Groceries Tax-Free". This Constitutional Amendment would prohibit local and state taxes on all foods for consumption, except for alcohol, tobacco and marijuana. Personal hygiene products were excluded from this measure. The State Legislature also put a measure on the ballot regarding bond funding for affordable housing

If you believe in and support any of the above measures, Please write letters to the Editor, talk to friends and family, share your facts and opinions at neighborhood meetings or help out at information booths at County Fairs and Community Celebrations. With everyone doing a little bit for our Initiatives and Candidates, we can be victorious. November 8th will be upon us before we realize it.
