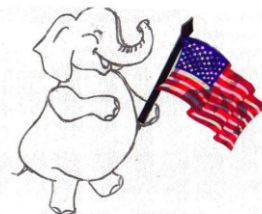

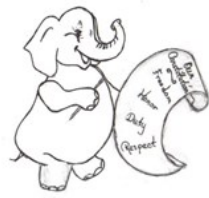
### How to Get Involved in Clackamas County
